8.	I am to encourage parents and guardians of any children in my charge to approach me directly at reasonable times (not during scheduled games) to discuss any issues pertaining to the team or their child;	
9.	I will comply with all requirements of the MGJAFC and the club in relation to coaching level accreditations;	
10.	If I have not completed a current AFL Level 1 Coaches Course I undertake to complete such course as soon as one becomes available.
